

OFFICIAL RAFFLE RULES AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

1. Raffle Period: The \$10,000 Giveaway Raffle will run from May 1, 2008 to July 28, 2008. Sales of the Raffle tickets in person will officially end on July 28, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time USA, except that tickets may be sold in person by the Caddie Classic Committee or its representatives on July 28, 2008 until the Caddie Classic Committee representative cuts off sales prior to the drawing. Entries by mail must be (i) postmarked by July 18, 2008 and (ii) received by the Caddie Classic by July 26, 2008. Entries received after such times shall not be entered into the Raffle. The Caddie Classic reserves the right to extend the Raffle Period in the event that the Caddie Classic 2008 golf outing is postponed or otherwise rescheduled. In such case, Raffle tickets may be sold up to a revised date as posted on this website. Entries will not be included in the drawing if full payment is not received by the Caddie Classic within the eligibility period. The Caddie Classic, however, reserves the right to terminate the Raffle for any reason by giving notice, deemed appropriate by the Caddie Classic, on the Caddie Classic web site at www.caddieclassic.com of its intentions to so terminate the Raffle. All Raffle proceeds shall be returned in the event that the Raffle is terminated prior to the drawing.
2. Eligibility: This Raffle is offered in the United States and Canada only, and to U.S. and Canada residents only, and does not discriminate against anyone participating based on race, sex, age, handicap, religion, national origin, or marital status. In addition, this Raffle is void in the state of Florida, the state of Rhode Island, and the state of New York, and residents of Florida, Rhode Island, and New York are not eligible to participate in this Raffle. Further, this Raffle is void where prohibited, and is void in any states requiring prior registration and/or bonding. All entrants must be at least 18 years of age to participate. By entering this Raffle you agree to these Rules and Eligibility Requirements, and to the final and binding decision of the independent Raffle judging organization which is Keating, Muething & Klekamp, P.L.L. In addition, by entering this Raffle you are warranting that you are eligible to participate in this Raffle under these rules. There is no limit on the number of entries. Entries become the sole property of the Caddie Classic. Your full name and phone number must be included on the entry form portion of the Raffle ticket in order to be eligible.
3. Methods of Entry: There are two ways to enter the Raffle: a) by purchasing a Raffle ticket from an authorized member of the Caddie Classic Committee or b) by sending in a mail-in entry, in each case within the time period set forth above. Tickets purchased by mail shall be sent to the Caddie Classic Golf Raffle, 3950 Virginia Avenue, Cincinnati, Ohio 45227.
4. Purchase Price. The price per Raffle ticket is One Hundred Dollars (\$100).
5. Drawing: The winner of the Golf Trip giveaway will be drawn at random from all the eligible entries received by the end of the Raffle period. The drawing will be done by Keating, Muething & Klekamp, P.L.L. on or about July 28, 2008 (see Raffle Period above). The winner will be notified by email, telephone, or regular mail within approximately seven calendar days of the drawing. For the name of the winner, please go to www.caddieclassic.com.
6. Odds of Winning and Prize Details: The main prize awarded under this Raffle will be \$10,000. If 300 tickets are not sold, winner gets 30% of the proceeds. All taxes and any other applicable costs and/or expenses will be the sole responsibility of the winner. Amounts paid for the Raffle tickets are not tax deductible. The odds of winning will be based upon the number of eligible entries received via mail, in person and via the internet. Upon notification, the Caddie Classic may require the winner to execute and return an Affidavit of Eligibility, and a Liability Release. Void where prohibited. The Evans Scholars Foundation and the Western Golf Association are third party intended beneficiaries of this paragraph and paragraph 7 and the Raffle. Prizes not claimed in writing on or before December 31, 2008 shall be void.
7. General Conditions: the Caddie Classic reserves the right to disqualify any entrant that in the Caddie Classic's sole discretion, has tampered with his or her entries, and/or has violated any other rules of this Raffle.
8. Limitations on Liability: The Caddie Classic is not responsible for any false, incorrect, inaccurate or incomplete information, whether caused by the web site, tampering, hacking, or any failure of the entrant's and/or the Caddie Classic's hardware, software, programming or any other similar technology or for any other reason. The Caddie Classic assumes no liability for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay, or problems in operation, transmission, communication, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to the Caddie Classic web site. The Caddie Classic is not liable for any damage to the entrant's computer in participating in this Raffle. If, for any reason, this Raffle is incapable of running due to force majeure, viruses, worms, bugs, hackers, tampering, technical failure, fraud or any other reason, the Caddie Classic reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify, or otherwise suspend this Raffle or eliminate purchases through the website. The Caddie Classic reserves the right to disqualify any entrant found to be disrupting the operation of the Raffle or web site. Disputes: Any disputes with the Caddie Classic, including any of its members, officers, representatives or agents or The Evans Scholars Foundation or the Western Golf Association or any of its affiliates, parent or subsidiary companies, or its employees, agents, owners, partners, directors or representatives that cannot be resolved between the parties arising out of, or pertaining to this Raffle shall be resolved individually without resorting to any form of class action, and shall be submitted to a court of competent jurisdiction in the City of Cincinnati, Ohio USA, which court shall apply the laws of the State of Ohio, without regard to Conflicts of Law. Further, under no circumstances will an entrant or proposed entrant be permitted to obtain damages awards for punitive, incidental, consequential damages, or for attorney's fees, other than entrant's actual out-of-pocket expenses incurred in entrant's participation in this Raffle.
